Industrial Action – Resident Doctors:

It is expected that further industrial action by resident doctors will begin next Friday (14 November) at 7 am and will run until 7 am on Wednesday, 19 November.

Plans are in place across the region to maintain patient safety and prioritise emergency services for those who need help the most. However, some patient services may be affected during this time.

For non-life-threatening illnesses and injuries, people are reminded to use NHS <u>111 online</u>, keeping 999 and hospital Accident and Emergency Departments for life-threatening emergencies only.

Anyone with a planned appointment or treatment during this time should attend unless they hear otherwise from the NHS. Any appointments that need to be changed will be rescheduled.

The vast majority of the NHS services will still be available as normal during this time, including GP practices and community pharmacies, which can help with a range of <u>common health concerns</u> and provide over-the-counter advice and treatments.
